Cinematograph Films Act 1975

1975 CHAPTER 73

An Act to make provision for payments by the British Film Fund Agency to the National Film Finance Corporation and for the application of those payments by that Corporation. [12th November 1975.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1.—(1) At the end of section 1(1) of the Cinematograph Films Act 1957 (which provides for the making by the British Film Fund Agency of certain payments) there shall be added the following:—

“ and

(e) with the approval of the Secretary of State, payments to the National Film Finance Corporation.”

Payments by British Film Fund Agency to National Film Finance Corporation. 1957 c. 21.

(2) In section 1(5) of that Act (consultation with the Cinematograph Films Council in connection with payments under certain paragraphs of subsection (1)) for the words “ or (d) ” there shall be substituted the words “ (d) or (e) ”.

2.—(1) Payments made to the National Film Finance Corporation under section 1(1)(e) of the Cinematograph Films Act 1957 shall be applied by the Corporation, in accordance with arrangements approved by the Secretary of State, in making loans or otherwise giving financial assistance for the purpose of enabling rights to be acquired or work to be undertaken with a view to the production of films.

Application of funds by National Film Finance Corporation.

1949 c. 20. (2) Section 2 of the Cinematograph Film Production (Special Loans) Act 1949 shall not apply to loans made by virtue of this section.

1960 c. 57. (3) In this section “ film ” has the same meaning as in section 38 of the Films Act 1960.

Citation and extent. 3.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Cinematograph Films Act 1975; and

(a) this Act and the Cinematograph Film Production (Special Loans) Acts 1949 to 1970 may be cited together as the Cinematograph Film Production (Special Loans) Acts 1949 to 1975; and

(b) this Act and the Cinematograph Films Acts 1957 to 1970 may be cited together as the Cinematograph Films Acts 1957 to 1975.

(2) This Act does not extend to Northern Ireland.
