ADMINISTRATION, GENERAL AND SUPPLEMENTAL

36 Short title, extent and commencement.

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Benefits Act 1976.
- (2) The following provisions only of this Act shall extend to Northern Ireland— Sections . . . ^{F1}34(1) (definitions of . . . ^{F1}"enactment"), 34(2), 35 and this section, in Schedule 6, paragraphs 1 and 5, in Schedule 7, paragraphs 7 to 13 and Schedule 8 so far as it specifies any enactment extending to Northern Ireland other than section 6 of, and Schedule 4 to, the ^{M1}National Insurance and Supplementary Benefit Act 1973 and any enactment in the ^{M2}Social Security Benefits Act 1975.
- (3) This Act shall come into force on 15th November 1976, but the repeal of any enactment specified in Part II of Schedule 8 to this Act which has not come into force before that date shall not take effect until immediately after that enactment comes into force.
