Solemn affirmations

6 Form of affirmation

(1) Subject to subsection (2) below, every affirmation shall be as follows:—

**I, _____ do solemnly, sincerely and
truly declare and affirm,**

and then proceed with the words of the oath prescribed by law, omitting any words of imprecation or calling to witness.

(2) Every affirmation in writing shall commence: —

and sincerely affirm,**
