102 Supplementary

- (1) In this Part—
 - (a) sections 95 to 99 shall be construed as one with the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1959;
 - (b) sections 100 and 101 shall be construed as one with the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964.
- (2) Where the Lord Chancellor at any time directs that any of the Acts listed in subsection (3) is to be reprinted, section 30 of the Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 shall apply as if—
 - (a) that direction were contained in an enactment; and
 - (b) in subsection (2) of that section for the words " the Clerk of the Parliaments " there were substituted the words " the Clerk to the Assembly ".
- (3) The Acts referred to in subsection (2) are—
 - (a) the County Courts Acts (Northern Ireland) 1959 and 1964;
 - (b) the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964; and
 - (c) the Judgments (Enforcement) Act (Northern Ireland) 1969.
