- (2) Sections 30(1) (husband and wife), 31(1) (effect on civil proceedings) and 34 (interpretation) of the ^{M1}Theft Act 1968, so far as they are applicable in relation to this Act, shall apply as they apply in relation to that Act.

- (4) In the ^{M2} Visiting Forces Act 1952, in paragraph 3 of the Schedule (which defines for England and Wales “offence against property” for purposes of the exclusion in certain cases of the jurisdiction of United Kingdom courts) there shall be added at the end—
“(j) the Theft Act 1978”.
- (5) In the Theft Act 1968 section 16(2)(a) is hereby repealed.
