#### *[<sup>F1</sup>Temporary stop notices*

#### **[<sup>F1</sup>9L Temporary stop notices: restrictions**

- (1) A second or subsequent temporary stop notice must not be issued in respect of the same works unless [<sup>F2</sup>Historic Environment Scotland has] in the meantime taken some other enforcement action in relation to the contravention of section 2(1) or (6) which is constituted by the works.
- (2) In subsection (1), “enforcement action” includes obtaining the grant of an interdict under section 9O.]
