

# Shipbuilding Act 1979

## **1979 CHAPTER 59**

## U.K.

An Act to raise the limits imposed by section 11 of the Aircraft and Shipbuilding Industries Act 1977 in relation to the finances of British Shipbuilders and its wholly owned subsidiaries; and to extend the application of section 10 of the Industry Act 1972 to include the alteration of completed and partially constructed ships and mobile offshore installations. ## 2 Guarantees in respect of alterations of ships, etc. U.K.

In section 10 of the <sup>MI</sup>Industry Act 1972 (which among other things authorises the Secretary of State to guarantee the payment of certain sums payable under arrangements for financing the construction of a ship or mobile offshore installation) in sub-section (9) (which provides that in that section "construction" includes the completion of a partially constructed ship or installation) after the word "installation" there shall be inserted the words " and the alteration of a ship or installation and of a partially constructed ship or installation ".
