



Import of Live Fish (England and Wales) Act 1980

1980 CHAPTER 27

2 Powers of entry and inspection.

- (1) While an order under section 1 of this Act is in force any officer commissioned by the Commissioners of Customs and Excise, ^{F1} or a person duly authorised by the Minister may at all reasonable times, on production of his authority if so required, enter and inspect any land occupied by a person holding a licence granted under that section and any other land upon which he has reason to believe that live fish, or the live eggs of fish, of the species specified in the order are being kept or may be found.
- (2) In this section “land” includes land covered with water but does not include a dwelling-house.
