Slaughter

33 Additional staff and expenses.

[^{F1}(1)] The Minister may, for the purposes of his powers under this Act relating to the slaughter by him of animals, [^{F2} birds or amphibians,] employ such additional inspectors, valuers and other persons, and at such remuneration, and may incur such expenses, as, subject to the approval of [^{F3}the Treasury], he thinks necessary.

[^{F4}(2) In this section, “animals” means any kind of mammal (except man).]
