28 Repeal of special licensing provisions in respect of new towns.

Part IV of, and Schedule 3 to, the ^{MI}Licensing (Scotland) Act 1976 (which make special provision for new towns as regards licensing with respect to alcoholic liquor) shall cease to have effect.
