

Deep Sea Mining Act 1981

1981 CHAPTER 53

11 Inspectors.

- (1) The Secretary of State [^{F1} or the Scottish Ministers] may appoint as inspectors to discharge such functions as may be prescribed and generally to assist him [^{F2}(or them)] in the execution of this Act such persons appearing to him [^{F2}(or them)] to be qualified for the purpose as he considers [^{F3}(or they consider)] appropriate from time to time.
- (2) The Secretary of State [^{F4}or the Scottish Ministers] may make to or in respect of any inspector appointed under subsection (1) above such payments by way of remuneration or otherwise as the Secretary of State [^{F5}or, as the case may be, the Scottish Ministers, may determine with the approval (in the case of an appointment by the Secretary of State)] of the Minister for the Civil Service.
