

# Civil Aviation Act 1982

## **1982 CHAPTER 16**

#### PART I

#### ADMINISTRATION

Regulation of performance by CAA of its functions

- 5 Duty of CAA to consider environmental factors when licensing [Flor issuing certificates for] certain aerodromes.
  - (1) Subject to section 4 above, it shall be the duty of the CAA, in exercising any aerodrome licensing [F2 or certification] function in relation to any aerodrome to which this section applies, to have regard to the need to minimise so far as reasonably practicable—
    - (a) any adverse effects on the environment, and
    - (b) any disturbance to the public,

from noise, vibration, atmospheric pollution or any other cause attributable to the use of aircraft for the purpose of civil aviation.

- (2) The reference in subsection (1) above to an aerodrome licensing function of the CAA is a reference to any function conferred on it by or under an Air Navigation Order with respect to the licensing of aerodromes.
- [F3(2A) The reference in subsection (1) above to an aerodrome certification function of the CAA is a reference to any function falling to be carried out by the CAA under the Aerodromes Regulation with respect to the certification of aerodromes.]
  - (3) This section applies to any aerodrome in the United Kingdom specified in an order made by the Secretary of State for the purposes of this section; but the Secretary of State may not specify in any such order an aerodrome which is designated for the purposes of section 78 below.
