### PART II

#### LOCAL AUTHORITY FUNCTIONS

#### **28 Islands or district council's functions in relation to the provision of clocks.**

[<sup>F1</sup>A local authority]—

- (a) may provide a clock for public purposes and may maintain, illuminate or remove such clock; and
- (b) where a clock is not owned by the [<sup>F2</sup>authority] but is open to public view, may for the purposes of securing its maintenance or illumination enter into an agreement with its owner.
