[^{F1} Interpretation of Part I.

In this Part of this Act—

“the Bus Company” means the National Bus Company; and

“subsidiary” shall be construed in accordance with [^{F2}section 736 of the Companies Act 1985]] and “wholly owned subsidiary” shall be construed in accordance with [^{F2}section 736(5)(b)] of that Act.
