#### TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS

##### *Repeal and amendment of Acts etc.*

- 3 Any power that is exercisable by virtue of—
- (a) section 317 of the <sup>M1</sup>Public Health Act 1936,
  - (b) section 82 of the Public Health Act 1961,
  - (c) section 82, 83 or 84 of the <sup>M2</sup>London Government Act 1963,
  - (d) section 252 or 254 of the <sup>M3</sup>Local Government Act 1972, or
  - (e) section 48 of the <sup>M4</sup>Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982,
- in relation to a provision that is repealed and re-enacted by this Act is exercisable in relation to that provision as so re-enacted to the extent to which it would have been exercisable immediately before such repeal.
