MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL

23 Power of Secretary of State to make grants.

- (1) The Secretary of State may [^{F1}, subject to such conditions as he thinks fit,] make ^{F2} . . . payments ^{F2} . . . to any body whose activities appear to him to be likely to promote the development or understanding of cultural or scientific matters.
- (2) Any payments under this section shall be made out of money provided by Parliament.
