

# Family Law (Scotland) Act 1985

### **1985 CHAPTER 37**

Matrimonial property, etc.

## 25 Presumption of equal shares in household goods.

- (1) If any question arises (whether during or after a marriage [F1 or civil partnership]) as to the respective rights of ownership of the parties to a marriage [F2 or the partners in a civil partnership] in any household goods obtained in prospect of or during the marriage [F1 or civil partnership] other than by gift or succession from a third party, it shall be presumed, unless the contrary is proved, that each has a right to an equal share in the goods in question.
- (2) For the purposes of subsection (1) above, the contrary shall not be treated as proved by reason only that while
  - $[F^3(a)]$  the parties were married
  - The partners were in civil partnership,] and living together the goods in question were purchased from a third party by either party alone or by both in unequal shares.
- (3) In this section "household goods" means any goods (including decorative or ornamental goods) kept or used at any time during the marriage [F5 or civil partnership in any family] home for the joint domestic purposes of the parties to the marriage [F6 or the partners], other than—
  - (a) money or securities;
  - (b) any motor car, caravan or other road vehicle;
  - (c) any domestic animal.
