CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS

Brine Pumping (Compensation for Subsidence) Act 1891 (c. 40)

- 1 (1) Notwithstanding anything in section 50 of the Brine Pumping (Compensation for Subsidence) Act 1891 (persons excluded from right to compensation), a local authority is entitled to compensation in accordance with the provisions of that Act in respect of any injury or damage to houses belonging to them which were provided under a housing scheme towards the losses on which the Secretary of State, or any predecessor of his, was liable to contribute under the ^{M1}Housing, Town Planning, &c. Act 1919 at any time before 10th August 1972.
- (2) In sub-paragraph (1) “local authority” means a county council, district council or London borough council, the Common Council of the City of London or the Council of the Isles of Scilly.
