INDIVIDUAL INSOLVENCY: GENERAL PROVISIONS

373 Jurisdiction in relation to insolvent individuals.

- (1) The High Court and the [FI county court] have jurisdiction throughout England and Wales for the purposes of the Parts in this Group.
- (2) For the purposes of those Parts, [F2the county court] has, in addition to its ordinary jurisdiction, all the powers and jurisdiction of the High Court; and the orders of the court may be enforced accordingly in the prescribed manner.
- (3) Jurisdiction for the purposes of those Parts is exercised—
 - (a) by the High Court [F3 or the [F4 county court]] in relation to the proceedings, which, in accordance with the rules, are allocated to the London insolvency district, and
 - (b) by [F5the] county court in relation to the proceedings which are so allocated to [F6any other insolvency district].
- (4) Subsection (3) is without prejudice to the transfer of proceedings from one court to another in the manner prescribed by the rules; and nothing in that subsection invalidates any proceedings on the grounds that they were initiated or continued in the wrong court.
