JURISDICTION OF COURTS IN ENGLAND AND WALES

[F2]F12 Jurisdiction: general.

- (1) A court in England and Wales shall not make a section 1(1)(a) order with respect to a child unless—
 - (a) it has jurisdiction under the Council Regulation, or
 - (b) the Council Regulation does not apply but—
 - (i) the question of making the order arises in or in connection with matrimonial proceedings [F3 or civil partnership proceedings] and the condition in section 2A of this Act is satisfied, or
 - (ii) the condition in section 3 of this Act is satisfied.]
- [^{F4}(3) A court in England and Wales shall not make a section 1(1)(d) order unless—
 - (a) it has jurisdiction under the Council Regulation, or
 - (b) the Council Regulation does not apply but—
 - (i) the condition in section 3 of this Act is satisfied, or
 - (ii) the child concerned is present in England and Wales on the relevant date and the court considers that the immediate exercise of its powers is necessary for his protection.
