## JURISDICTION OF COURTS IN ENGLAND AND WALES

## [<sup>F1</sup>[<sup>F2</sup>2 Jurisdiction: general.

- (1) A court in England and Wales shall not make a section 1(1)(a) order with respect to a child unless—
  - (a) it has jurisdiction under  $^{F3}$ ...[<sup>F4</sup> the Hague Convention], or
  - (b) [<sup>F5</sup>the Hague Convention does not apply] but—
    - (i) the question of making the order arises in or in connection with matrimonial proceedings [<sup>F6</sup>or civil partnership proceedings] and the condition in section 2A of this Act is satisfied, or
    - (ii) the condition in section 3 of this Act is satisfied.]
- [ A court in England and Wales shall not have jurisdiction to make a special <sup>F7</sup>(2A) guardianship order under the Children Act 1989 unless the condition in section 3 of this Act is satisfied.
  - (2B) A court in England and Wales shall not have jurisdiction to make an order under section 26 of the Adoption and Children Act 2002 unless the condition in section 3 of this Act is satisfied.]

[ A court in England and Wales shall not have jurisdiction to make an order under  $^{F8}(2C)$  section 51A of the Adoption and Children Act 2002 unless—

- (a) it has jurisdiction under <sup>F9</sup>... the Hague Convention, or
- (b) [<sup>F10</sup>the Hague Convention does not apply] but the condition in section 3 of this Act is satisfied.]

[<sup>F11</sup>(3) A court in England and Wales shall not make a section 1(1)(d) order unless—

- (a) it has jurisdiction under  $^{F12}$ ... $[^{F13}$  the Hague Convention], or
  - (b) [<sup>F14</sup>the Hague Convention does not apply] but—
    - (i) the condition in section 3 of this Act is satisfied, or
    - (ii) the child concerned is present in England and Wales on the relevant date and the court considers that the immediate exercise of its powers is necessary for his protection.]]
