



# Crown Proceedings (Armed Forces) Act 1987

## 1987 CHAPTER 25

### 3 Consequential adaptations of existing enactments etc.

- (1) Except in so far as an order under section 2 above otherwise provides, any reference to section 10 of the <sup>M1</sup>Crown Proceedings Act 1947 in any Act passed, or subordinate legislation made, before the passing of this Act shall be construed as a reference to that section as it from time to time has effect by virtue of this Act.
- (2) Subsection (1) above shall apply, as it applies to express references to the said section 10—
  - (a) to the references to that section which are comprised in the references in the said Act of 1947 to or to the provisions of that Act itself; and
  - (b) to any other references to the said section 10 which are comprised in references to that Act, in references to enactments generally or in references to any description of enactments.
- (3) In this section “subordinate legislation” has the same meaning as in the <sup>M2</sup>Interpretation Act 1978.
