1987 CHAPTER 35

An Act to amend the Protection of Animals Act 1911 to increase the penalties for offences against animals under section 1(1). [15th May 1987]

Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—^{F1}
