

Motor Vehicles (Wearing of Rear Seat Belts by Children) Act 1988

1988 CHAPTER 23

An Act to make provision for the wearing of rear seat belts by children; and for connected purposes. [28th June 1988]

Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—
