Finance and administration

5 Determination of financial duties of Scottish Homes.

- (1) The Secretary of State may ^{F1} . . . determine the financial duties of Scottish Homes, and different determinations may be made in relation to different general functions, powers and activities of Scottish Homes.
- (2) The Secretary of State shall give Scottish Homes notice of every determination, and a determination may—
 - (a) relate to a period beginning before the date on which it is made;
 - (b) contain incidental or supplemental provisions; and
 - (c) be varied by a subsequent determination.
