## **Recording for purposes of time-shifting.**

- [F1(1)] The making [F2 in domestic premises] for private and domestic use of a recording of a broadcast F3... solely for the purpose of enabling it to be viewed or listened to at a more convenient time does not infringe any copyright in the broadcast F3... or in any work included in it.
- [F4(2)] Where a copy which would otherwise be an infringing copy is made in accordance with this section but is subsequently dealt with—
  - (a) it shall be treated as an infringing copy for the purposes of that dealing; and
  - (b) if that dealing infringes copyright, it shall be treated as an infringing copy for all subsequent purposes.
  - (3) In subsection (2), "dealt with" means sold or let for hire, offered or exposed for sale or hire or communicated to the public. ]
