1990 CHAPTER 34

An Act to provide for the acquisition of British citizenship by selected Hong Kong residents, their spouses and minor children. [26th July 1990]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
