##### *Financial provisions*

#### **24 Financial duties of Scottish Enterprise.**

- (1) After consultation with Scottish Enterprise, the Secretary of State may <sup>F1</sup> . . . determine the financial duties of Scottish Enterprise; and different determinations may be made in relation to different functions and activities of the body.
- (2) The Secretary of State shall give Scottish Enterprise notice of every determination under subsection (1) above; and such a determination may—
  - (a) relate to a period beginning before the date on which it is made;
  - (b) contain incidental or supplemental provisions; and
  - (c) be varied by a subsequent determination under that subsection.
