



# Radioactive Material (Road Transport) Act 1991

## 1991 CHAPTER 27

### 1 Preliminary.

- (1) [<sup>F1</sup> In this subsection (which applies for the purposes of section E5 of Part 2 of Schedule 5 to the Scotland Act 1998) ] “radioactive material” means any material having a specific activity in excess of—
- (a) 70 kilobecquerels per kilogram; or
  - (b) such lesser specific activity as may be specified in an order made by the Secretary of State;

and the power to make an order under this subsection shall be exercisable by statutory instrument which shall be subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.
