FURTHER PROVISIONS REGARDING DROUGHT ORDERS

Miscellaneous

- An interruption or diminution of the supply of water shall not affect the right of a water authority to recover any fixed or minimum charge, including a community water charge imposed in accordance with the provisions of Part I of Schedule 5 to the Abolition of Domestic Rates Etc. (Scotland) Act 1987.
- The Secretary of State may require a water authority or a water development board on whom powers have been conferred by a drought order to furnish him with such information relating to the exercise by them of any of these powers as he considers necessary to enable him to discharge his functions under Part III of this Act.
