PART I

POWERS OF STATUTORY WATER COMPANIES

Arrangements and reconstructions

9 Arrangements and reconstructions by certain companies.

- (1) [^{F1}Part 26 of the Companies Act 2006] (arrangements and reconstructions) shall have effect in relation to statutory water companies that are not limited companies with such modifications as may be prescribed by regulations made by the Secretary of State.
- (2) Section 213 of the ^{M1}Water Industry Act 1991 (procedure for making regulations and supplemental powers) shall apply in relation to the making of regulations under this section as it applies in relation to the making of regulations under that Act.
- (3) In this section “limited company” means a company, within the meaning of the 1985 Act, which is limited by shares.
