INDUSTRIAL INJURIES AND DISEASES (OLD CASES)

PART I

WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION AND INDUSTRIAL DISEASES BENEFIT IN RESPECT OF EMPLOYMENT BEFORE 5TH JULY 1948

Continuation of workmen's compensation

The Workmen's Compensation Acts and any other enactment specified in Schedule 9 to the original Industrial Injuries Act which was repealed by section 89 of that Act shall continue to apply to any cases to which, if the 1967 Act had not been passed, they would have applied by virtue of the said section 89, being certain cases where a right to compensation arises or has arisen in respect of employment before 5th July 1948.
