## PART I

#### STANDARDS OF PERFORMANCE AND SERVICE TO CUSTOMERS

### Electricity supply

### 25 Determination of disputes by Director: interim directions.

- (1) The power of the Director General of Electricity Supply, under section 23(2) of the <sup>M1</sup>Electricity Act 1989, to require a public electricity supplier to continue a supply of electricity pending the Director's determination of a dispute shall be extended to enable the Director to require the giving of a supply of electricity pending such a determination.
- (2) Accordingly, in section 23(2) of that Act, the words "to continue" shall be omitted, in both places where they occur.
