

## Protection of Animals (Scotland) Act 1993

## **1993 CHAPTER 15**

An Act to increase the penalties for certain offences under the Protection of Animals (Scotland) Act 1912. [27th May 1993]

E IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. In section 1(1) of the Protection of Animals (Scotland) Act 1912 Increased penalty (actings which as respects animals constitute offence of cruelty), for the for certain acts of words from "a fine" to the end there shall be substituted the words cruelty to animals. "imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to a fine not 1912 c. 14. exceeding level 5 on the standard scale or to both".

2.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Protection of Animals (Scotland) Act 1993; and it extends to Scotland only.

Citation, extent and commencement.

(2) This Act shall come into force at the end of the period of two months beginning with the day on which it is passed; and it has no effect in relation to any offence committed before it comes into force.
