GENERAL PROVISIONS

23 Orders and directions.

- (1) Any power of the Secretary of State to make orders under ^{F1}... II shall be exercised by statutory instrument which shall be subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.
- (2) Orders under ^{F1}... II may make different provision for different cases, circumstances or areas and may contain such incidental, supplementary or transitional provisions as the Secretary of State thinks fit.
