[^{F1}137A Transfer of sheriff court summary proceedings within sheriffdom

(1) Where [^{F2}this subsection applies,] the prosecutor may apply to the sheriff for an order for the transfer of the proceedings to a sheriff court in any other district in that sheriffdom and for adjournment to a diet of that court.

[Subsection (1) above applies—

- $^{F3}(1A)$ (a) where the accused person has been cited in summary proceedings to attend a diet of the court; or
 - (b) if the accused person has not been cited to such a diet, where summary proceedings against the accused have been commenced in the court.]
 - (2) On an application under subsection (1) above the sheriff may make such order as is mentioned in that subsection.]
