# [F147D Penalty for using rail vehicle without accessibility compliance certificate E+W

[F2]If a regulated rail vehicle to which section 47A(1) applies is used for carriage at a time when no rail vehicle accessibility compliance certificate is in force for the vehicle, the Secretary of State may require the operator of the vehicle to pay a penalty.]]
