#### MINOR AND CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS

##### *Colonial Stock Act 1877*

- 24 At the end of subsection (1) of section 4 of the <sup>M1</sup>Colonial Stock Act 1877 there shall be added the words “or, in relation to Scotland, subscribed in accordance with section 7 of the Requirements of Writing (Scotland) Act 1995.”.
