#### MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL

##### *Miscellaneous financial provisions*

#### 92 Grants by local authorities.

- (1) The council of a county, district, county borough [<sup>F1</sup>London borough, parish or community] may make grants to any [<sup>F2</sup>police and crime commissioner] whose police area falls wholly or partly within the [<sup>F1</sup>council's area].
- (2) The council of a London borough, county, [<sup>F3</sup>district or parish] which falls wholly or partly within the metropolitan police district may make grants <sup>F4</sup>... to the [<sup>F5</sup>Mayor's Office for Policing and Crime].
- (3) Grants under this section may be made unconditionally or, with the agreement of the chief officer of police for the police area concerned, subject to conditions.
- (4) This section applies to the Council of the Isles of Scilly as it applies to a county council.

### 93 Acceptance of gifts and loans.

- (1) A [<sup>F6</sup>local policing body] may, in connection with the discharge of any of its functions, accept gifts of money, and gifts or loans of other property, on such terms as appear to [<sup>F7</sup>the body] to be appropriate.
- (2) The terms on which gifts or loans are accepted under subsection (1) may include terms providing for the commercial sponsorship of any activity of the [<sup>F8</sup>local policing body] or of the police force maintained by it.

### 94 Financing of new [<sup>F10</sup>police and crime commissioners ].

- (1) The Secretary of State may make grants to any [<sup>F11</sup>police and crime commissioner] in respect of expenditure incurred (or to be incurred) by [<sup>F12</sup>the commissioner] at any time before the beginning of its first precepting year.
- (2) Without prejudice to any other powers to borrow, a [<sup>F13</sup>police and crime commissioner] may borrow by way of temporary loan or overdraft from a bank or otherwise any sums which [<sup>F14</sup>the commissioner] may require for the purpose of meeting [<sup>F15</sup>the commissioner's] expenditure before the beginning of [<sup>F15</sup>the commissioner's] first precepting year.
- (3) The sums borrowed by [<sup>F16</sup>a commissioner] under this section shall not exceed such amount as the Secretary of State may determine, and shall be repaid before the end of [<sup>F17</sup>the commissioner's] first precepting year.
- (4) For the purposes of this section the “first precepting year” of [<sup>F18</sup>a police and crime commissioner] is the financial year in which revenue is first received by [<sup>F19</sup>the commissioner] as a result of a precept issued by [<sup>F19</sup>the commissioner] under Part I of the <sup>M1</sup>Local Government Finance Act 1992.

[<sup>F23</sup>**95A Charging of fees by College of Policing**

- (1) The College of Policing may charge fees for providing services of a public nature only if—
  - (a) the services are of a specified description and are provided with a view to promoting the efficiency, effectiveness or professionalism of the police, and
  - (b) the fees are of a specified amount or are determined in a specified manner.
- (2) In this section “specified” means specified in an order made by the Secretary of State.
- (3) A statutory instrument containing an order under this section shall be subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.]
