PART I

ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO AN ARBITRATION AGREEMENT

Costs of the arbitration

60 Agreement to pay costs in any event.

An agreement which has the effect that a party is to pay the whole or part of the costs of the arbitration in any event is only valid if made after the dispute in question has arisen.
