## 61 Reporting of assertions: commencement and supplementary.

- (1) [F1Section 58 applies where the offence mentioned in subsection (1) or (2) of that section is committed on or after the appointed day.]
- (2) [F1The reference in subsection (1) to the appointed day is to such day as is appointed for the purposes of this section by the Secretary of State by order.]
- (3) [FINothing in section 58 or 59 affects any prohibition or restriction imposed by virtue of any other enactment on a publication or on matter included in a programme.]

- (6) In section 159 of the M1Criminal Justice Act 1988 (appeal to Court of Appeal against orders restricting reports etc.) in subsection (1) the following paragraph shall be inserted after paragraph (a)—
  - "(aa) an order made by the Crown Court under section 58(7) or (8) of the M2Criminal Procedure and Investigations Act 1996 in a case where the Court has convicted a person on a trial on indictment;".
