## 1996 CHAPTER 58

### PART I

#### [<sup>F1</sup>SCOTTISH NATURAL HERITAGE'S DEER FUNCTIONS]

#### 2 Advice and annual reports to Secretary of State.

(1) [<sup>F1</sup>SNH] shall—

- (a) advise the Secretary of State on any such matter relating to the purposes of this Act as he may refer to [<sup>F2</sup>it]; and
- (b) bring to his attention any matter relating to deer of which in the opinion of [<sup>F1</sup>SNH] he ought to be apprised.
