[^{F1}SCOTTISH NATURAL HERITAGE'S DEER FUNCTIONS]

2 Advice and annual reports to Secretary of State.

- (1) [^{F1}SNH] shall—
 - (a) advise the Secretary of State on any such matter relating to the purposes of this Act as he may refer to [^{F2}it]; and
 - (b) bring to his attention any matter relating to deer of which in the opinion of $[^{F1}SNH]$ he ought to be apprised.
