[^{F1}Other offences and attempts to commit offences]

24 Attempts to commit offences.

Without prejudice to the operation of section 294 of, and paragraph 10 of Schedule 3 to, the ^{MI}Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1995, any person who—

- (a) attempts to commit; or
- (b) does any act preparatory to the commission of,

an offence under section 5(5) or this Part of this Act shall be guilty of an offence.
