PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES

Exemptions and reliefs

- The Treasury may by order confer in relation to the Office, to such extent as may be specified—
 - (a) exemption or relief (by way of refund or otherwise) from prohibitions, restrictions, duties and taxes on the importation of goods;
 - (b) relief of the kinds set out in paragraphs 6 and 7 of Schedule 1 to the MIInternational Organisations Act 1968 (importation and supply of hydrocarbon oil and other goods or services).
