#### THE BOARD AND ITS COMMITTEES

##### PART IV

##### GENERAL

- 22 (1) The Board, the Professional Conduct Committee [<sup>F1</sup>, the Appeals Committee] and any committee established by the Board may exercise its functions even though there is a vacancy among its members.
- (2) No proceedings of the Board, the Professional Conduct Committee [<sup>F1</sup>, the Appeals Committee] or any committee established by the Board are invalidated by any defect in the <sup>F2</sup>... appointment of a member.
