



Police (Property) Act 1997

1997 CHAPTER 30

2 Disposal of property used, or intended for use, for purposes of crime: England and Wales.

- (1) Section 43 of the ^{M1}Powers of Criminal Courts Act 1973 (power to deprive offender of property used, or intended for use, for purposes of crime) is amended as follows.
- (2) In subsection (5)—
 - (a) for “section 2(1)” there is substituted “ section 2 ”,
 - (b) after “shall” there is inserted “ subject to subsection (6) below ”, and
 - (c) after “regulations for disposal” there is inserted “ (including disposal by vesting in the relevant authority) ”.
- (3) After that subsection there is inserted—
 - (6) The regulations may not provide for the vesting in the relevant authority of property in relation to which an order has been made under section 43A of this Act.
 - (7) Nothing in subsection (2A)(a) or (3) of section 2 of the ^{M2}Police (Property) Act 1897 limits the power to make regulations under that section by virtue of subsection (5) above.
 - (8) In subsections (5) and (6) above “relevant authority” has the meaning given by section 2(2B) of the Police (Property) Act 1897.”
