[^{F1}9E [^{F2}OGA's] security and resilience functions

- (1) This Part does not limit the exercise of the [^{F3}OGA's] security and resilience functions.
- (2) This Part is subject to the exercise of the security and resilience functions by the [^{F4}OGA].
- (3) In this section “security and resilience function” means any function which relates to—
 - (a) the security of petroleum supplies, or
 - (b) the resilience of the petroleum industry.]
