###### *Payments to former members of the Commission*

- 8 Where a person—
- (a) ceases to be a member of the Commission by reason of its abolition; and
  - (b) does not become the Ombudsman,
- the Secretary of State may make to the person a payment of such amount as the Secretary of State may determine.
