1998 CHAPTER 34

Licences: general provisions

24 [F¹Delegation of functions by the licensing authority.]

- (1) The functions of the [F²licensing authority] under this Act (apart from any power to make subordinate legislation) may be exercised by any person appointed by the [F²licensing authority] for the purpose to such extent and subject to such conditions as may be specified in the appointment.
- (2) An appointment under this section may authorise the person appointed to retain any fees received by him.
- (3) It is the duty of a person appointed under this section to comply with any directions given to him by the [F²licensing authority] in relation to the exercise of functions under this Act.
